

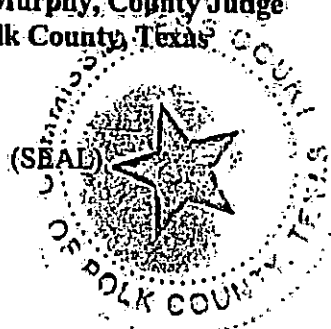

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-9-15

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND LEVYING MUNICIPAL AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF CORRIGAN, TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR 2020, DIRECTING THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Corrigan finds that the Ad Valorem Tax for the year 2020, hereinafter levied for current expenses of the City and the general improvement of the City and its properties, is in all respects necessary and must be levied to provide the revenue requirements of its budget for the ensuing year; and


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Corrigan, Texas seeks to adopt a tax rate that will DECREASE property taxes from last year's budget by \$6,983.00 and of that amount, \$5,681.97 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORRIGAN, TEXAS:


That the City of Corrigan, acting through its Mayor and City Council, hereby sets the AD VALOREM MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION TAX RATE AT \$0.3096 PER \$100 VALUATION and the AD VALOREM DEBT TAX RATE AT \$0.1104 PER \$100 VALUATION, for the total amount for 2020 AD VALOREM TAX RATE OF \$.4200 PER \$100 VALUATION.
